In reviewing the administrative directive issued by Mr. William Yamoah, Secretary, Presidential Elections Committee, on August 26, 2025, pursuant to the motions on transitional provisions adopted at the National Delegates Conference in Accra on July 19, 2025, on the upcoming presidential voter register, it has become apparent that there is a significant lack of clarity regarding the "definition" of "All External Branch Executives" who are eligible to vote in the forthcoming Presidential NPP Primaries scheduled on January 31, 2026. This lack of clarity is a matter of concern and requires immediate attention.

The interpretations and explanations proffered thus far seem unclear as to who constitutes, in our (NPP-USA) case, our Branch Executives. This confusion underscores the necessity for a comprehensive discussion and clarification.


Given the urgency for the Branch to submit our voters' list to NPP-Ghana in the next few days, it is crucial that we address this issue promptly. I'm calling for an emergency Branch Executive Committee (BEC) meeting within the next five (5) days to discuss this matter so we can educate our Chapters.
